

# Site redesign

Redesign a "local-to-you" website using the HTML and CSS skills you have developed this semester. "Local-to-you" means the site can be local to Des Moines or to your home town.

You should design a new homepage (index.html) and one inside page for the site. The inside page should be able to serve as a template for other inside pages. Each page should link to the other using either top or side navigation (for the sake of your navigation, you can pretend there are other pages on the site, even though you are not creating those pages).

Turn your site in by uploading all files to a folder named "redesign" on your web site (I should find your redesign by going to `yourdomain.com/redesign`). When you are done, e-mail a link to your site and a link to the original website (the one you are redesigning) to `chris.snider@drake.edu` with the subject line "Site redesign." Include in your e-mail a list of three ways you improved on the current website design.

- Coding with clean HTML and CSS (external style sheet).
- The overall design, creativity and usability of the site.
- Smart selection of content for the site.
